Response to Senate Bill 272
June 30, 2016

STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE:

In October, 2015, the California Legislature enacted Senate Bill 272 (SB272) – A Bill requiring local agencies to create a “catalog” of information technology (IT) systems that they use to manage data. The Bill doesn’t require disclosure of records or data sets; rather it asks local agencies to make and inventory and based on that inventory, create and post online a catalog of their data management systems, hardware, and software applications. The hope is that this catalog will provide the state with an inventory of systems in use by local agencies, so as to better plan and facilitate the development of more open, accessible, integrated, and modern data management systems.”

SB272 CATALOG OF ENTERPRISE SYSTEMS GUIDELINES

In preparing the City of Willows’ Catalog of Enterprise Systems, City of Willows Staff used the following definitions and guidelines set for in SB272:

An “enterprise system” is defined as a software application or computer system that collects, stores, exchanges, and analyzes information that the agency uses. The enterprise system must be a multi-departmental system or system with information collected about the public; and, a system of record that serves as an original source of data within the agency.

THE INVENTORY CATALOG OF ENTERPRISE SYSTEMS ARE TO INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. System vendor
2. System product
3. Brief statement of system purpose
4. Description of types of data
5. Department that is system’s primary custodian
6. Frequency system data is collected
7. Frequency system data is updated

THE INVENTORY CATALOG SHOULD NOT INCLUDE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. IT Security Systems, including firewalls and other cybersecurity systems
2. Physical access control systems, employee identification management systems, video monitoring, and other physical control systems

3. Infrastructure and mechanical control system, including those that control or manage street lights, electrical, natural gas, or water and sewer functions
4. Systems related to 911 dispatch and operation or emergency services
5. Systems that would be restricted if disclosure would reveal vulnerabilities or increase potential for attack on an IT system of the public agency (Section 6254.19)
6. The specific records that the IT system collects, stores, exchanges or analyzes

Nothing should be construed to permit public access to records held by an agency to which access is otherwise restricted by statute or to alter the current process for requesting public records. If public interest is better served by not disclosing full details, the agency will provide system name, brief title, or identifier of the system.

The catalog is to be posted on the website by July 1, 2016 and updated annually.

CITY OF WILLOWS IMPLEMENTATION:

Each City Department reviewed the guidelines and determined which of their enterprise systems, if any, met the criteria for inclusion in the City of Willows' inventory catalog. Department personnel compiled the required information, leveraging the assistance of the County's IT Support vendor, Matson & Isom Technology Consulting as needed. Information received from all departments was then consolidated and put into the format currently posted on the City website.

In identifying what enterprise systems should and should not be included in the City's Inventory Catalog, Staff was advised to error on the side of caution in ensuring that information submitted did not compromise the security of systems, data, or the interests of the public.
